2. Apply for a garden.

You are responsible for site prep, planting and aftercare.

1. Site prep:
 - Locate underground utility lines (as, phone, cable, etc).
 - **Contact Ontario One Call - www.on1call.com or 1-800-400-2255.**
2. Remove existing vegetation. No new topsoil or soil amendment needed.

3. Planting:
 - Plants are delivered for same day planting. Advice on planting & placement given. Please provide a garden trowel, watering can and water.
